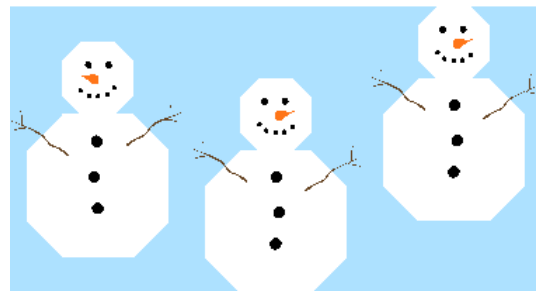


# Patti's Frosty Friends

Designed by Patti Carey for EQ7: Seasons Row-a-long 2015



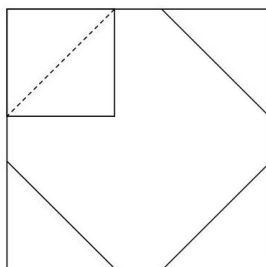
**Finished Size:** 8" high x 60" wide

**Number of Blocks & Finished Size:** 12 blocks, each 5" wide x 6" high

Fabric Requirements	Yards	Cutting
Snow white solid (Northcott's ColorWorks #9000-11)	1/3yd	◊ Cut 2 strips 4 1/2" x wof (width of fabric); cut each strip into (6) 4 1/2" squares and (6) 2 1/2" squares.
Sky blue (Northcott's Toscana #9020-43)	1/2yd	◊ Cut 1 strip 5 1/2" x wof; cut into (7) 2 1/2" pieces & (10) 1 1/2" pieces. ◊ Cut 5 strips 1" x wof; cut into (24) 6 1/2" pieces & (48) 1" squares. ◊ Cut 4 strips 1 1/2" x wof; cut into (24) 2 1/2" pieces & (48) 1 1/2" squares.

## Piecing:

**1.** Lay a 1" blue square face down in each corner of a 2 1/2" white square. Sew diagonally through the blue squares; trim 1/4" beyond seam and press triangles toward corner.



**2.** Lay a 1 1/2" blue square face down in each corner of a 4 1/2" white square. Sew diagonally through the blue squares; trim 1/4" beyond seam and press triangles toward corner.

**3.** Sew a 1 1/2" x 2 1/2" blue piece to opposite sides of each 2 1/2" white square from step 1 above; press seam toward blue.

**4.** Sew a unit from step 3 to each 4 1/2" unit from step 2, pressing seam toward step 3 unit.

**5.** Sew a 1" x 6 1/2" blue strip to each side of each snowman unit, pressing seam toward blue.

**6.** Sew a 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" blue piece to top and bottom edges of 5 blocks, pressing seams toward blue.

**7.** Sew a 2 1/2" blue piece to top edge of 4 snowman blocks, pressing seam toward blue.

**8.** Sew a 2 1/2" blue piece to bottom edge of 3 snowman blocks, pressing seam toward blue.

**9.** Using the diagram below as a guide, arrange the blocks into a row; sew together, pressing seams to one side.

**10.** Add eyes, nose, mouth, buttons and arms to each snowman using your favorite method (appliqué, embroidery, fabric paint, fabric marker).
