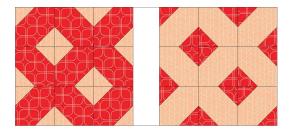




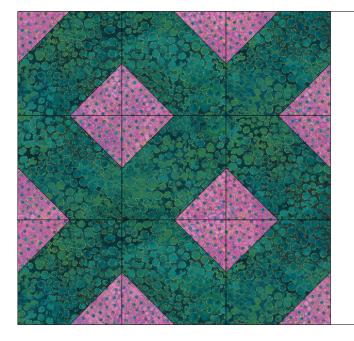
## FREE PATTERN

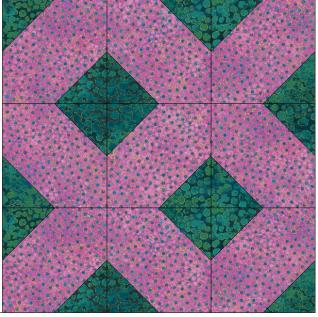


Blocks shown in FIGO Midsommar (above), Banyan Vino (right) and Northcott Shimmer (below)

















- Make the same block twice
- Blocks are positive/negative

Make 1, 2 or all 3 size options for a mini, throw or queen-size quilt.

Mini: 32½" x 41½" Throw: 69" x 89" Queen: 93¾" x 118½" Each quilt has 48 blocks.

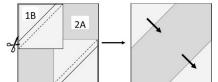

## Piecing:

1. Lay (2) #1B squares in opposite corners of each #2A square, right sides facing. Draw a

diagonal line from corner to corner on each #1B square and sew along line; trim  $\frac{1}{4}$ " beyond line and press seams in direction of arrow. Make 9. Repeat with the #2B and #1A squares.





2. Arrange the units from step 1 as shown in 3 rows of 3 for each block, noting the direction

of the pressed seams. Sew into rows, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows, then sew the rows together, pressing in direction of arrows (spin the seam allowances at the 4 intersections). Your block should measure 5" (mini)/9½" (throw)/12½" (queen) edge-to-edge.
