# Time to Quilt Block 2

- Make the same block twice
- Blocks are positive/negative

Make 1, 2 or all 3 size options for a mini, throw or queen-size quilt.

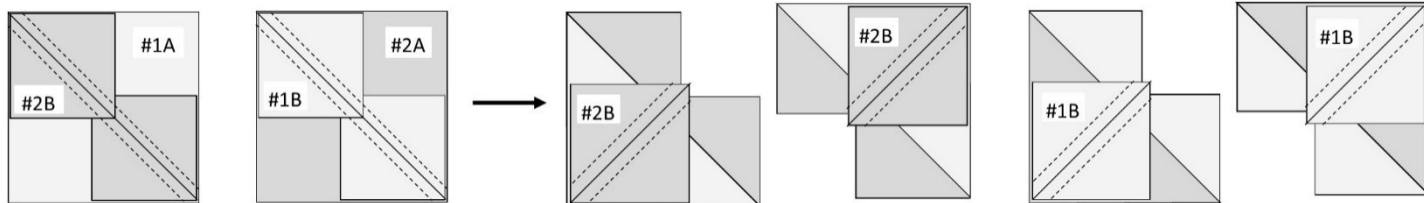
**Mini:** 32½" x 41½"    **Throw:** 69" x 89"    **Queen:** 93¾" x 118½" Each quilt has 48 blocks.

## Cutting:

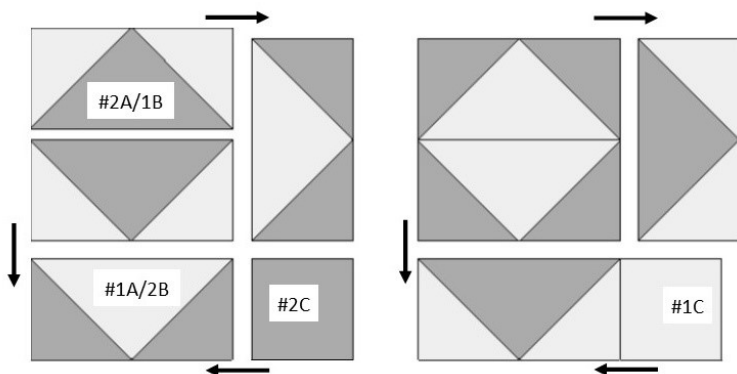
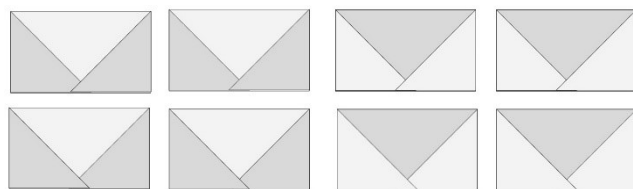
Fabrics	FIGO Midsommar mini 4½" finished block	Banyan Vino throw 9" finished block	Northcott Shimmer super- size 12" finished block
Quantity & sku	A 20" x 4½" piece each of peach 90007-56 (#1) & red 90137-26 (#2)	fat¼ each of taupe corks 80224-35 (#1) & brown corks 80224-26 (#2)	fat¼ each of mauve 22994M-85 (#1) & jade 22991M-63 (#2)
Cut from <b>each</b> fabric	◇ Cut (1) 4¼" square (A), (4) 2⅜" squares (B) and (1) 2" square (C).	◇ Cut (1) 7¼" square (A), (4) 3⅞" squares (B) and (1) 3½" square (C).	◇ Cut (1) 9¼" square (A), (4) 4⅞" squares (B) and (1) 4½" square (C).

## Piecing:

1. Select the A and B squares. Lay a #2B square face down in opposite corners of a #1A square. Repeat with a #2A square and (2) #1B squares as shown. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner through B squares. Sew ¼" each side of drawn line and cut along line; press seams toward B.



2. Lay a #2B square in remaining corner of each #1A/2B unit. Repeat with the #1B squares on the #2A/1B units as shown. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner through B square. Sew ¼" each side of drawn line and cut along line; press seams toward B. Make a total of 4 of each flying geese unit.



3. Arrange the units from step 2 as shown. Sew the 2 matching geese units together to form a square, pressing seam open. Sew into rows, then sew the rows together, pressing seams in the direction of the arrows. Your block should measure 5" (mini)/9½" (throw)/12½" (queen) edge-to-edge.
