Quilt patterns using efficient time-saving methods


Finished Size: 12" square Skill level: Confident beginner


Fabric	Cutting Instructions
A – background (teal)(fat¼)	♦ Cut one 12½" square.
B – light sheep (beige)(fat1/8)	♦ Cut 3 pieces of Template 1, one piece of Template 2 and 2 pieces of
	Template 3.
C – dark sheep, feet, eyes (black)(fat%)	♦ Cut 1 piece using Template 1 and 8 pieces each of Template 5 and 6.
D – light faces (cream)(scrap)	♦ Cut 3 pieces of Template 2 and 6 pieces of Template 3.
E – hair (light rust)(scrap)	♦ Cut 4 pieces of Template 4.
F – Wonder-Under fusible web (⅓yd)	

Press Fabric A square in half vertically and horizontally to find the center.

Appliques:

- **1.** For each of fabrics B-E trace the required number of applique pieces onto the paper side of the Wonder-Under. If desired, trim ¼" inside the traced line on the larger shapes to maintain softness of pieces.
- **2.** Following manufacturer's directions, fuse the traced Wonder-Under onto the back of each designated fabric. Cut out shapes along traced line and remove paper backing.
- **3.** Using block image as a guide, position the Template 1 pieces on Fabric A square, centering them in each quadrant. Tuck the Template 5 pieces under the Template 1 pieces. Add the Template 2, then 3, then 4, then 6 pieces as shown in image. Fuse in place following manufacturer's directions.
- **4.** Secure edges of appliques using your preferred method (zigzag, buttonhole stitch, edge-stitch ½" from edge).
