
Fabrics used: Northcott's Toscana suede-look texture and Canvas texture

□= cut once diagonally


Fabric	Cutting Instructions
A -background - (#9020-97 graphite)	♦ Cut (4) 3¾" squares ☒, (8) 2¾" squares ☒ & (2) 12½" x 2" pieces
B – rose geese (#9020-221 make me blush)	♦ Cut 1 piece using Template 1 and 1 piece using Template 2
C – red geese (#9020-231 valentino)	♦ Cut 1 piece using Template 1 and 2 pieces using Template 2
D – green geese (#9020-733 par 4)	♦ Cut 1 piece using Template 1 and 2 pieces using Template 2
E – yellow geese (#9030-510 sunshine)	♦ Cut 1 piece using Template 1 and 1 piece using Template 2
F – teal geese (#9020-64 sea glass)	♦ Cut 2 pieces using Template 2

Piecing: All seams are ¼" unless noted.

Tip for aligning patches for sewing: When you have 2 patches to be sewn together and they are sloped at opposite angles, they are correctly aligned when they meet at the \(\mathcal{U}'' \) seam line as shown at right. When you have 2 patches to be sewn together and only one is sloped at an angle, they are correctly aligned when they meet 1/2" from the edge as shown at far right. However, sew them together with a 1/2" seam.



- 1. Sew the long edge of a 3%" Fabric A triangle to short edges of each B, C, D and E Template 1 triangle, using tip above to align pieces and pressing seams away from A.
- 2. Similarly, sew the long edge of a 23/8" Fabric A triangle to short edges of each B, C, D, E and F Template 2 triangle, using tip above to align pieces and pressing seams away from A.
- 3. Referring to the diagram, sew the 4 units from step 1 together, pressing seams toward large triangles. Similarly, sew the units from step 2 together.
- 4. Arrange the segments from step 3 alternately with the 2" x 12½" Fabric A pieces. Sew together as shown, pressing seams toward 2" strips.





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
