

## CANOE LAKE

**Finished Size:** 12" square **Skill level:** Intermediate

Fabrics used: Canoe Lake by Patti Carey for Banyan Batiks and Toscana suede-

look texture by Northcott

## Label all pieces as indicated for easier assembly

Fabric	Cutting Instructions
A –center (preprinted	♦ Cut (1) 8½" square, centering a motif in the square.
mini panel #80700-34)	
<b>B</b> –panel frame, bear	♦ Cut 1 strip 1" x wof; cut into (2) 8½" pieces ( <b>B1</b> ) and (2) 9½" pieces ( <b>B2</b> ).
claws (forest green	♦ Cut 2 strips 1¾" x wof; cut into (40) 1¾" squares ( <b>B3</b> ).
#81300-79)	
C – bear palms -	♦ Cut 1 strip 1½" x wof; cut into (20) 1½" squares ( <b>C</b> )
(green/tan #80702-34)	
<b>D</b> – background (tan	♦ Cut 1 strip 2" x wof; cut into (4) 3½" pieces ( <b>D1</b> ).
#9020-14)	$\diamond$ Cut 2 strips 1%" x wof; cut into (40) 1%" squares ( <b>D2</b> ) and (20) 1" squares ( <b>D3</b> ).

**Piecing:** All seams ¼". Press toward Fabric A unless indicated.


- 1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of each D2 square.
- **2.** Lay each D2 face down on a B3 square; sew  $\frac{1}{2}$ " each side of the drawn line, cut along line and press seam toward B.




**3.** Select a C piece, a D3 square and 4 units from step 2. Sew units together in pairs as shown, making 20 of each pair, then arrange in 2 rows of 2 with the C and D3 pieces. Sew into rows, pressing seams toward C & D3, then sew rows together.









- 4. Repeat steps 2-3 to make a total of 20 Bear's Paw blocks.
- **5.** Sew a B1 piece to each side of A, then sew a B2 to top and bottom edges; press seams toward B.

**6.** Following diagram at right, sew 2 blocks to short ends of each D1 piece. Referring to layout diagram below, sew a segment to each side of framed A, noting the orientation of the blocks.





**7.** Add a block to each end of remaining segments as shown and sew to top and bottom edges of A, noting orientation of blocks. Press seams toward B.
