



THE GROVE

Finished Size: 12" square (12½" edge-to-edge)

Skill level: Intermediate

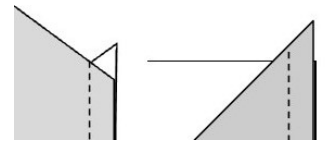
Fabrics used: Toscana suede-look texture by Northcott

◊ = cut once diagonally ⊠ = cut twice diagonally

Fabric	Cutting Instructions
A –light green (#9020-73 rainforest)	◊ Cut (3) 5¼" squares ⊠ (A)
B –medium green (#9020-78 pine)	◊ Cut (2) 5¼" squares ⊠ (B)
C – brown (#9020-37 cinnamon)	◊ Cut (3) 1" x 1½" pieces (C)
D – dark green background (#9020-782 basil)	◊ Cut (15) 2⅞" squares ◊ (D1), (6) 2¼" x 1½" pieces (D2), (2) 4½" x 3½" pieces (D3) and (2) 4½" x 2" pieces (D4)

Piecing: All seams are ¼". Press toward darker fabric unless indicated.

Tip for aligning patches for sewing: When you have 2 patches to be sewn together and they are sloped at opposite 45° angles, they are correctly aligned when they meet at the ¼" seam line as shown at right.



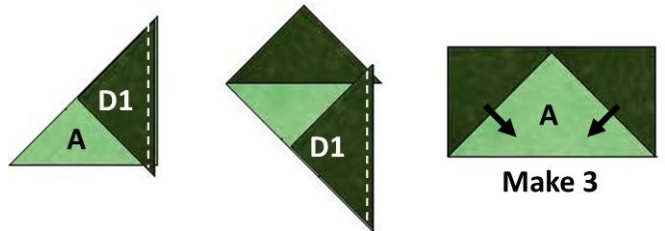
When you have 2 patches to be sewn together and only one is sloped at a 45° angle, they are correctly aligned when they meet ⅜" from the edge as shown at right. However, sew them together with a ¼" seam.

Tree sections: 4" wide x 4½" high (4½" wide x 5" high edge-to-edge)

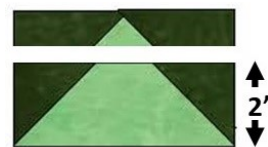
Each tree block has 3 segments: the top segment is 2½" high edge-to-edge, the middle segment is 2" high edge-to-edge, and the bottom segment is 1½" high edge-to-edge. Each of the triangular segments is constructed in the same manner, however the middle and bottom segments are trimmed to size.

Trunk-less Tree:

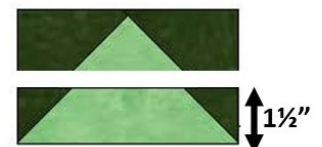
1. Select (3) A triangles and (6) D1 triangles.
2. Sew the long edge of each D1 triangle to the short edges of each A triangle, pressing seams toward A. Unit should measure 2½" x 4½".



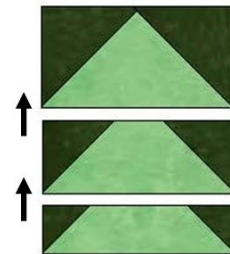
3. Trim one segment to 2" high by trimming excess from the TOP edge of the segment as shown at right.



4. Trim one segment to 1½" high by trimming excess from the TOP edge of the segment as shown at far right.



5. Arrange the 3 segments in a column as shown, with the untrimmed segment at the top and the 1½" segment at the bottom. Sew segments together, pressing seams toward top segment. Repeat with 6 additional A pieces to make a total of (3) A trees.



Make 3

Tree with trunk:

6. Select (2) B triangles and (4) D1 triangles.

7. Sew the long edge of each D1 triangle to the short edges of each B triangle, pressing seams toward B.



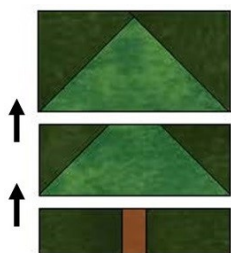
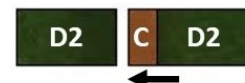
Make 2



Trim 1 to 2"

8. Trim one segment to 2" high by trimming excess from the TOP edge of the segment.

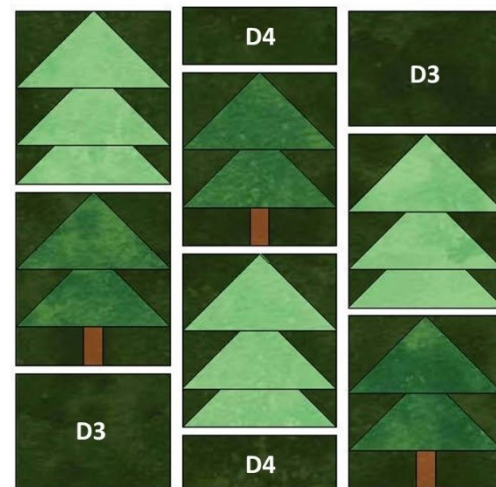
9. Sew a D2 piece to each long edge of a C piece, pressing seams toward C.



Make 3

10. Arrange the 3 segments in a column as shown, with the untrimmed segment at the top and the C/D/C tree trunk segment at the bottom. Sew segments together, pressing seams toward top segment. Repeat with 4 additional B pieces to make a total of (3) B trees.

11. Arrange the A and B tree sections alternately in 3 columns, adding the D3 and D4 pieces to top/bottom end(s) of columns as shown. Sew columns together.
