



HOME SWEET HOME

Finished Size: 12" square (12½" edge-to-edge)

Skill level: Confident Beginner/Intermediate

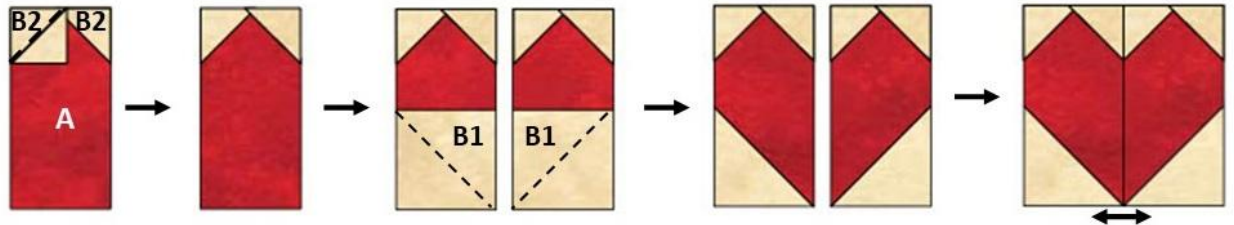
Fabrics used: Toscana suede-look texture by Northcott

Label pieces as indicated in the cutting chart for ease of construction.

Fabric	Cutting Instructions
A – red heart (#9020-24 cardinal)	◇ Cut (2) 2½" x 1½" pieces (A)
B – ecru (#9020-30 shortbread)	◇ Cut (2) 1½" squares (B1) and (4) 1" squares (B2)
C – yellow (#9020-52 yellow brick road)	◇ Cut (1) 2½" x 1½" piece (C1) and (1) 3½" x 1½" piece (C2)
D – tan (#9020-352 latte)	◇ Cut (1) 3½" x 1½" piece (D1) and (1) 4½" x 1½" piece (D2)
E – gold (#9020-54 mac & cheese)	◇ Cut (1) 4½" x 1½" piece (E1) and (1) 5½" x 1½" piece (E2)
F – medium brown (#9020-37 cinnamon)	◇ Cut (1) 5½" x 1½" piece (F1) and (1) 6½" x 1½" piece (F2)
G – orange (#9020-571 monarch)	◇ Cut (1) 6½" x 1½" piece (G1) and (1) 7½" x 1½" piece (G2)
H – dark brown (#9020-36 chocolate)	◇ Cut (1) 7½" x 1½" piece (H1), (1) 8½" x 1½" piece (H2), (1) 4½" x 1½" piece (H3) and (1) 3" x 1½" piece (H4)
I – green tree (#9020-78 pine)	◇ Cut (1) 3½" x 2" piece (i1) and (4) 3½" x 1½" piece (i2)
J – blue (#9020-43 blue moon)	◇ Cut (1) 4½" square (J1), (1) 4½" x 4" piece (J2), (1) 4½" x 2" piece (J3), (1) 8½" x 1½" piece (J4), (2) 3" x 1½" pieces (J5), (2) 2" squares (J6) and (8) 1½" squares (J7)
K – black roof (#9020-99 ebony)	◇ Cut (1) 10½" x 4½" piece (K)

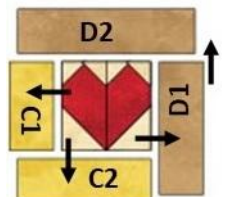
General Piecing: All seams are ¼" unless noted.

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of each B square. Lay a B2 in adjacent corners face down on a short edge of each A piece. Stitch along line (**Tip:** Stitch on the "corner" side of the line), trim ¼" from stitching line and press seam toward A.



2. Lay a B1 square face down in corner of each A piece, orienting the B1 pieces as shown; stitch along line, trim ¼" from stitching line and press seam toward A. Sew the A pieces together as shown, pressing seam open. Unit should measure 2½" square.

3. Following the diagram at right, sew C1 to left edge of heart unit, pressing seam toward C. Continuing counterclockwise around block and keeping ends even, add C2 to bottom edge, then D1 to right edge and D2 to top edge, pressing seam toward strip just added.



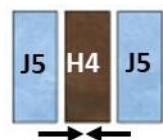
4. Continuing counterclockwise, add the E, F, G and H pieces. Segment should measure 8½" edge-to-edge.



5. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the back of each J6 and J7 square. Lay a J7 square face down on opposite ends of each i2 piece as shown; sew along line, trim ¼" from stitching line and press seam toward i2. Make 4 units measuring 3½" x 1½"

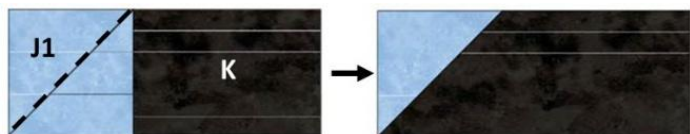


6. Lay a J6 square face down in corner of i1; sew along line, trim ¼" from stitching line and press seam toward i. Repeat with remaining corner as shown to make one tree top unit measuring 2" x 3½".



7. Sew a J5 piece to each long edge of H4, pressing seam toward H. Unit should measure 3½" x 3".

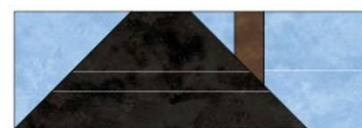
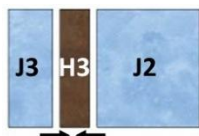
8. Arrange the units from steps 5, 6 and 7 as shown. Sew together, pressing seams toward tree top. Segment should measure 3½" x 8½".



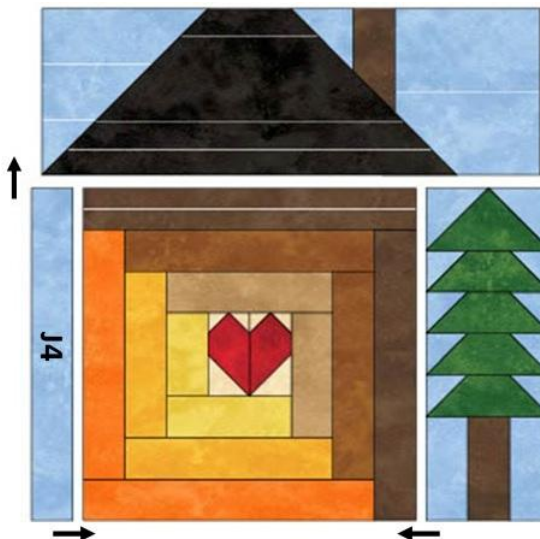
9. Lay J1 face down on one end of K. Draw a diagonal line on J1 from corner to corner, stitch along line and trim ¼" from stitching line. Press seam toward K.

10. Sew the J2 and J3 pieces to long edges of H3; press seams toward H.

11. Lay unit face down on remaining end of K piece, aligning J3 with the top edge of K. Sew diagonally as shown, trim ¼" beyond sewing line and press seam toward K. Segment should measure 12½" x 4½".



12. Arrange J4 and the segments from steps 4, 8 and 11 following diagram. Sew J4 and tree segment to sides of log cabin segment, pressing seams toward center. Add the roof segment to top of block, pressing seam toward roof.
