

ON THE ROCKS

Finished Size: 12" square (12½" edge-to-edge)
Skill level: Confident Beginner/Intermediate

Fabrics used: Toscana suede-look texture and ColorWorks solid by Northcott

Label pieces as indicated in the cutting chart for ease of construction.

Fabric	Cutting Instructions
A – red beverage (#9020-26 hot sauce)	♦ Cut 1 circle using template (A)
B – red ice cube (#9020-221 make me blush)	♦ Cut (1) 3½" square (B)
C – yellow beverage (#9020-54 mac & cheese)	♦ Cut 1 circle using template (C)
D – yellow ice cube (#9020-530 custard)	♦ Cut (1) 3½" square (D)
E – amber beverage (#9020-590 tangerine tango)	♦ Cut 1 circle using template (E)
F – amber ice cube (#9000-382 apricot)	♦ Cut (1) 3½" square (F)
G – brown beverage (#9020-37 cinnamon)	♦ Cut 1 circle using template (G)
H -brown ice cube (#9020-34 bamboo)	♦ Cut (1) 3½" square (H)
I – glass rim (#9020-91 silver lining)	♦ Cut enough ½" wide bias strips to make 70".
J – background (#9020-340 raffia)	♦ Cut (1) 12½" square

General Piecing: All seams are ¼" unless noted.


- 1. Press under ¼" on outer edges of each B, D, F and H square.
- **2.** Pin B square in center of A circle; invisibly hand- or machine-stitch in place.
- **3.** Press outer edge of A circle under $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Tip: With right side down, I use my Clover Hera Marker for Applique to score the fabric along the seam line.




- **4.** Repeat steps 2-3 with the C circle and D square, the E circle and F square, and the G circle and H square.
- **5.** Arrange circles on J square as desired, leaving the outer $\frac{1}{2}$ " of square free. Pin in place and invisibly stitch to J.
- **6.** Join Fabric I pieces end-to-end with mitered seams; trim seam allowances to $\frac{1}{8}$ " and remove dog ears. Press under edges to make a $\frac{3}{16}$ " wide strip. <u>Tip:</u> The Clover $\frac{1}{4}$ " bias maker tool works well for this.



7. Position bias strip along outer edge of A, covering edge of A. Invisibly hand- or machinestitch the outer edge in place, then stitch the inner edge in place. Repeat with C, E and G circles.
